Sub: - Operation of Essential Services.

Due to increase in COVID-19 cases, Government of Karnataka issued guidelines to break the chain of COVID-19 2nd wave, which shall be in force from 27-04-2021, 9 p.m. to 12-05-2021, 6 a.m. During this period BMTC bus services to general public are suspended.

As per the guidelines, BMTC will operate 150 essential ordinary services in 95 routes from 06:00 hrs to 19:00 hrs for the benefit of employees working in State and Central Government Departments and in essential service sectors. For the movement of Air travel passengers 06 Vayuvajra schedules are operated between Kempegowda Bus Station and Kempegowda International Airport for 24 hrs.

As per the guidelines issued by the government, the employees working in essential service sectors shall only be allowed to travel, **General public are not allowed.**

Number of people travelling in buses restricted to 50% of the seating capacity.

Crew and passengers are requested to compulsorily follow COVID-19 guidelines.
